

## Work Instruction for cleaning leather dress covers

### DAILY LEATHER CLEANING WHILE CABIN CLEANING WITH WIPES

- Use Perrone's Leather Cleaner Wipes (#SW-145 100 Wipes a can ) to clean and condition lightly soiled small spots.
- With a clean lint free cloth, gently wipe soil and excess chemical from surface.
- Allow a few minutes to dry and cure prior to sitting on cover.

### FOR Medium DUTY CLEANING - weekly

#### **Leather Cleaner with Conditioner - <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=hMtz7PC82Ac>**

- Use Perrone's Leather Cleaner with Conditioner (#CC-332 Spraycan) to clean and condition lightly soiled dress covers.
- Use a clean lint-free cloth or Perrone's horsehair brush (recommended) to apply Leather Cleaner with Conditioner to leather dress cover. Agitate area to be cleaned in a circular motion. Do not apply excessive pressure. Horsehair is small enough to go into pores.
- With a clean lint free cloth, gently wipe soil and excess chemical from surface.
- Allow a few minutes to dry and cure prior to sitting on cover.

### FOR HEAVY SOILED SEAT COVERS with the Deep Cleaner - monthly

- Use Perrone's Deep Cleaner (#DC-332 Spraycan) to remove heavy soils from leather dress covers. - <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=jzn1amWlQbg>
- Use a clean lint-free cloth or Perrone's horsehair brush (recommended) to apply Deep Cleaner to leather dress cover. Agitate area to be cleaned in a circular motion. Do not apply excessive pressure. Only Horsehair is small enough to go into pores.
- Remove soil and excess chemical from dress cover with a clean lint free cloth.
- Allow leather to air dry prior to using Perrone's Leather Conditioner.

- Dispense Perrone Leather Conditioner (#CN-216) into clean, lint-free cloth and apply to covers, panel by panel.
- Lightly remove an excess build-up of chemical on dress cover.
- Allow to air dry and cure.

#### **Ink Removal - <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=WMWycRX3CJg>**

- Apply a small amount of Perrone's Ink Remover (#IR-202) to soiled area.
- Allow product to stand on soiled area for 3-5 minutes.
- Gently agitate chemical with clean, lint-free rag, cloth or cotton swab/stick - turning constantly as not to redeposit ink on leather.
- Additional applications may be required. If so, dry area and repeat process.
- Note: If ink stains have dried into leather, Perrone's ink remover will remove surface ink – appearance will be to lighten the stain.

#### **Chewing gum Removal - <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=m6aAgZxXIK0>**

- Apply a small amount of Perrone's Deep Cleaner (#DC-332) to soiled area.
- Allow product to stand on soiled area for 3-5 minutes.
- Careful scrape with the tongue spatula - craft stick and push the chewing gum from the leather . Additional applications may be required. If so, dry area and repeat process with the spatula and with the Perrone's brush.
- Leather Conditioning afterwards
